This was discussed at the meeting and asked to be taken back to your team to discuss.  
No changes have been made at this time.

**STATISTICIAN POSITION:** This role will be available for the new season. Lots of paperwork. Role includes; tracking penalties, collecting game sheets, tracking team & player points & attendance

### Treasurers Report:

- Started season with \$20,589.84. Ended season with **\$16,499.12** (no outstanding bills)
- \$9500 over budgeted (due to Desboro ice surface).
- Each team paid \$923.50 to play.
- Changing account to enable e-transfers for referees & scorekeepers to ensure payments are going through immediately rather than waiting for cheques to be deposited. This was voted on during meeting and majority of teams **VOTED YES.**
- MONEY IN THE BANK: Overage from tournament fundraising & COVID. Do we leave money in league account and reduce the league fees per team next season or do we return funds to team accounts? AND if returned does this include Slapshots? **\*\*TABLED TO PRE SEASON MEETING**
- Keeping \$5,000 - \$6,000 in account for January tournament & insurance.
- Discussion that constitution should state what is done with extra money at the end of the season so a rule is in place and being followed thoroughly.

### Schedule:

- All teams returning as of right now.
- Teams have until August 01/22 to add new team or resign existing team.
- Everyone still on board for Keady & Tara ice availability. Keady - \$125 / Tara - \$95.36
- Wiarion suggested as additional ice surface as Desboro will not be re-opening & it has been said there is quite a lot of available ice time in Wiarion. Interest in Wiarion throughout week rather than Saturday nights in Tara. All this will be dependent on ice surface availability.

- Mixed reviews on whether teams preferred to play once a week or twice a week. Many teams struggled with commitment having the Saturday night games. That being said league did not have much of a choice as time slots were very limited due to minor hockey.
- Game schedule is picked through the draw of a hat to ensure fairness, and who you play at the end of the season just happens to be who you play in the start.
- Playoffs: Most teams have expressed that they would like to have a league tournament at the end of the year. Unfortunately weren't able to pull together this season due to a number of contributing factors.

#### Referees:

- Fees are going up to \$35 to ensure keeping Roger in league.
- To be fair this needs to be paid to all referees.
- WE NEED MORE REFS!!
- Discussion on setting up a referee clinic to get more interest in the position. We discussed covering some of the cost as an incentive to get people out.

#### Open Discussion:

- JANUARY TOURNAMENT: Do the women want to host or is it the guys turn to host? We need to find out whose turn is up & make decision on what is best.
